English Cities Fund - a joint venture between Muse Developments, Legal & General Property and the Homes and Communities agency - are developing the wider Salford Central scheme, with Timekeeper's Square and Vimto Gardens at the core.

The development comprises 36 Georgian informed townhouses located in the stunning surroundings of the Grade 2 listed neo-classical Church of St Philip's and opposite Salford Cathedral.

The two, three and four bedroom homes range in height, from two, three and four storeys.

A landscaped communal courtyard sits at the heart of the development, with a pedestrian boulevard leading from the church.

Key points

The high-quality contemporary designs are perfect for those looking to retreat to the tranquillity of a community setting just minutes away from Manchester city centre.

Features

Built to the highest specification and using materials that will define the properties, these new additions to Chapel Street play a key role in the future of Salford's regeneration.

All have parking and the majority have a rear garden. The three and four bedroom homes have private roof top gardens in addition to their rear gardens.
