Muse crowned best developer in the North West

Leading developer and urban regeneration specialist, Muse Developments, has been voted 'Developer of the Year' at the prestigious Insider North West Property Awards.

Dubbed the 'property Oscars', the award ceremony saw more than a thousand of the industry's leading figures gathered at Manchester Central to celebrate the sector's success stories from the past year.
