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Tony Macaroni opens new restaurant at Marischal Square

Fast growing Italian restaurant Tony Macaroni is the latest addition to the list of top quality eateries to begin trading at Aberdeen's prestigious Marischal Square development in the heart of the city centre.

The new 155-seat restaurant officially opened this weekend and became the 15th in the Tony Macaroni family serving the brand's award-winning, authentic Italian cuisine featuring a state of the art, Italian made, Marana Forni wood fired pizza oven.
